

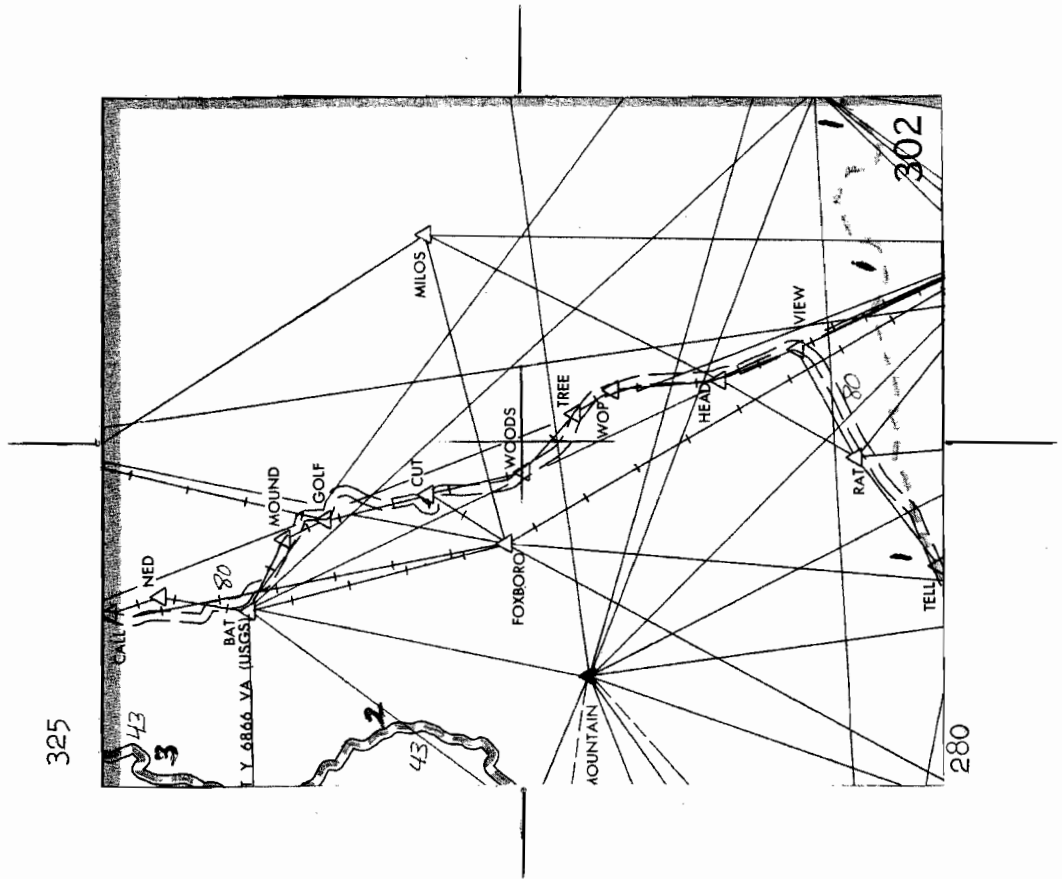

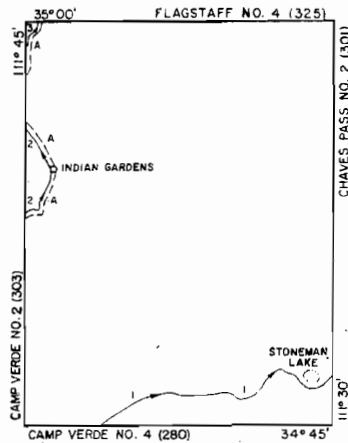

- Stoneman Lake, 4.4 mi. SW. of; E. of top of flat ridge; 15 ft. S. of rd.; in lava rock; standard tablet stamped "R 10 1931" 6198.218
- Stoneman Lake, 1.4 mi. SW. of; on SW. side of top of ridge; 130 ft. SE. of rd.; in rock ledge; standard tablet stamped "R 11 1931" 6611.966
