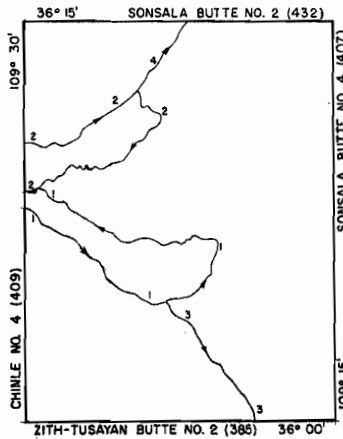

FROM CHINLE NO. 4 QUADRANGLE ABOUT 3.5 MILES SE. OF CHINLE, SOUTHEAST ALONG FORT DEFIANCE ROAD TO BAT TRAIL, THENCE NORTHEAST ALONG BAT TRAIL TO JUNCTION OF CANYON DE CHELLY AND MONUMENT CANYON, THENCE NORTHWEST IN CANYON DE CHELLY TO CHINLE QUADRANGLE AGAIN (by E. E. Harris, 1936; Book B 7238)

- ✓ Junction of Canyon de Chelly and Monument Canyon; about 8.0 mi. SE. of White House ruins; about 500 ft. E. of jct. of canyons and about 300 ft. W. of base of canyon wall; on wide flat; in sandstone boulder; standard tablet stamped "1936 H 10 5854" 5854.563

- ✓ White house ruins, 5.4 mi. SE. of; NW. side of rd. NW. of creek; at point where rd. leaves creek and runs W. along base of cliff; standard tablet set vertically and stamped "US NPS BM 20 5792" 5792.454
- ✗ White house ruins, 4.4 mi. SE. of; 30 ft. S. of rd. and 5 ft. above rd. level; in sandstone boulder; standard tablet stamped "US NPS BM 19 5774" (Reported destroyed, 1955) 5773.813
- ✗ White house ruins, 3.6 mi. SE. of; 30 ft. N. of angle in rd. around base of canyon wall; opposite side canyon to S.; in sandstone ledge 3 ft. higher than rd.; standard tablet stamped "1936 H 11 5751" (Reported destroyed, 1955) 5751.575

Antelope house ruins, 0.1 mi. SW. of; on W. edge of canyon; at point where creek flows close to wall of canyon; about 0.4 mi. S. of forks of Black Canyon; and where rd. follows high ground around point of mountain; 4 ft. above ground; set vertically; standard tablet stamped "US DI NPS EM NO 103 5734" 5733.906

Antelope house ruins, 0.6 mi. SW. of; N. edge of canyon; in base of canyon wall; 4 ft. above ground; set vertically; standard tablet stamped "US DI NPS EM NO 104 5719" 5718.745

Antelope house ruins, 1.2 mi. SW. of; on S. edge of canyon; opposite side canyon to N.; at point where creek flows against canyon wall; in angle of canyon wall; 3 ft. above creek; set vertically; standard tablet stamped "US DI NPS EM NO 105 5696" 5695.824

Antelope house ruins, 2.2 mi. SW. of; on W. edge of canyon; at point where creek flows close to canyon wall; 3 ft. above creek and set vertically; standard tablet stamped "US DI NPS EM NO 106 5663" 5662.864

Antelope house ruins, 2.9 mi. SW. of; on NW. edge of canyon where rd. crosses creek and follows high ground around point of canyon wall; 2 ft. above ground and set vertically; standard tablet stamped "US DI NPS EM NO 107 5614" 5641.034

Chinle, 14.5 mi. SE. of along the Chinle-Ft. Defiance Road; on NW. edge of angle in old rd.; NW. side of new rd. and at forks of dim rd. W.; in root on W. side of leaning pinon tree; copper nail and washer 6817.48

Chinle, 14.9 mi. SE. of along Chinle-Ft. Defiance Road; 11 ft. NE. of center of rd. at start of down grade; in rock ledge; standard tablet stamped "1937 H 85 6847" 6847.385

Reference mark, 70 ft. SW. of tablet; in root on NW. side of 10-in. pinon tree; copper nail and washer 6849.98

Chinle, 16.1 mi. SE. of along Chinle-Ft. Defiance Road; on NE. edge of rd.; at crossing of old rd.; in base of W. side of leaning forked pinon tree; rail spike 6893.76

Chinle, 16.8 mi. SE. of along Chinle-Ft. Defiance Road; 15 ft. W. of center of angle in rd. in drain; in prominent sandstone ledge in center of drain; standard tablet stamped "1937 H 86 6894" (Reported destroyed, 1955) 6894.715

Chinle, 9.8 mi. NE. of along Chinle-Lukachukai Road; on N. edge of rd. in drain; on prominent sandstone ledge; chiseled square 6645.68

Chinle, 10.7 mi. NE. of along Chinle-Lukachukai Road; 86 ft. NW. of center of rd.; W. side of small drain running NW.-SE.; in rock ledge; standard tablet stamped "1936 H 110 6749" 6748.660
