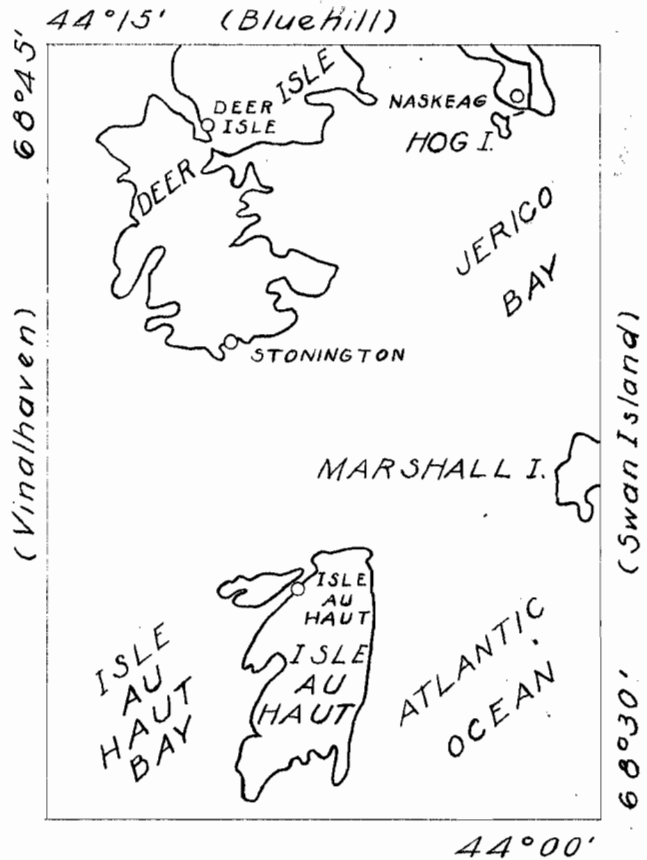

SW. of BM No. 2, and about 8 ft. out from the edge of vegetation, elev. 13.01 ft. above mean low water 7.93 ft. above half tide level, 2.85 ft. above mean high water
